### Is it the truth or the Truth?

What we know is; there are things that are true for everyone (absolute) and things that are true based on personal experience. It is not that often that my wife and I see different colors (especially when picking out something to wear on Sunday morning). What she sees as gray, I see as purple... and so on. So what is true? Her version or mine? Well, the cloth was made in a particular color – a true color. So, either Susie is right that it is gray, I am right that it is purple, or we both are wrong. Only one option can be the real truth.

For the Christian, it is imperative that we recognize the difference because Jesus called us to recognize Truth (absolute) and distinguish it from truth (relative). John 14:6 records Jesus saying "I am the way, the truth and the life, no-one comes to the Father except through me." God has given us the Bible as a witness to the life, ministry, death, and resurrection of Jesus Christ as that TRUTH. The words, commands, encouragements, and convictions of Jesus are things that put us in touch with absolute Truth: Him! Jesus is not up for interpretation, and he is not subject to a relative point of view. The purposes of the church are not for our interpretation – they are clearly given in the Word; who is made flesh in Jesus! Jesus IS the way, truth and life. Jesus IS resurrection. So often we look to the world or to our comfort for truth, when we only need to look to the God-man Jesus for real Truth! Seek the Truth, and you will find answers to the way and the life.
