RE: Personal Commitment Letter of Understanding to serve as Handyman Minister for the Widow/Widower/Single/Ministry

The Widow/Widower/Singles Ministry Handyman Ministry Team is committed to respond to our widow/widower/singles requests for help, to escape or avoid distress, due to household or vehicle issues that require the attention of special skilled individuals. Widow/widower/singles find such tangible help to be a tremendous blessing and very supportive of the Ministry's goals to help them live-out their Spiritual Ministry with as much peace and comfort as possible. Secondly, to be a Christian witness to their family and friends.

I understand and commit to responsibly maintain the special trust and confidence that the KUMC widow/widower/singles have developed with KUMC. This trust extends to their personal safety as well as their property. Our commitment is that our ministry service motives will always be entirely based, without compromise, on their Spiritual, mental and physical well-being. The Handyman Ministry services may be requested by a widow/widower/single or by someone representing them. Most service requests are repairs to home, property or vehicle. Some repairs may require creative solutions. Some minor improvement work may be doable also – handrail or grab bar installation are examples. Sometimes good advice is the best that can be done. This ministry does not have a cash reserve to buy materials and there is no obligation for the Handyman Minister to pay for materials. I recognize that my primary ministry responsibility is to the widow/widower/single and will take appropriate time to minister in other obvious ways, including having prayer with them. I expect the widow/widower/single to be satisfied when I leave and have a way to contact me or the ministry if the unexpected occurs. I may call back to check up later. I will not send anyone outside the Ministry to the widow/widower/single's home to work without my presence. I may recommend a business and provide help in explaining the job, but the actual contracting of the job should be done by the person expected to make payment.

I understand that to be a member of the Handyman Ministry Team normally requires being at least twenty-one years of age and an active member of KUMC.

I accept the responsibility to maintain my Spiritual, church family, and community standing, consistent with these requirements and values, to be a Widow/Widower/Single Minister.
